SILA action in response to “the lifting of COVID-19 state of emergency on Sept. 30,2021.”

“The COVID-19 state of emergency” issued to 19 prefectures including Chiba Prefecture was lifted on September 30, but the new coronavirus infection has not completely ended. In order to prevent infection to faculty members and students, it will be necessary to continue to take thorough infection control measures from now on.

As in the past, each person will continue to take actions to prevent the spread of new coronavirus infection, such as wearing masks, grasping the health condition, and avoiding the three Cs (closed spaces, crowded places, close-contact settings) including daily checking the body temperatures as follows.

1 Thoroughness of infection prevention control measures.

- (1) Make sure to wear masks, wash hands, and gargle to prevent infection.
- (2) Every morning, use the body temperature sensor when you go to school and write down your health status on the board installed at the office counter.
- (3) Avoid enclosed, highly populated places where you could come in close contact with each other. Also ventilate the room. These steps for infection prevention must be adhered to completely.

2 When faculty members and students have cold symptoms such as high fever “including side reactions after vaccination.”

If you have an unusual physical condition such as high fever, please rest at home to reduce the risk of infection at our school. In this case, please be sure to contact us until the start of work.

3 When a family member living together has cold symptoms such as high fever “including side reactions after vaccination.”

Please refrain from going to work (going to school) if you have a cold symptom such as fever in your family.

4 When a person infected with a new coronavirus infection or a close contact person occurs.

Please contact the school and take a rest for the period specified by the health center or medical institution. (Treatment as a official absence)
